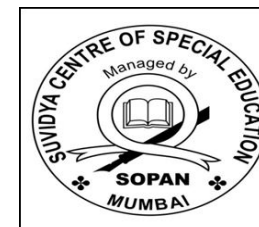

CERTIFICATE COURSE IN AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER

Autism is a complex neurobehavioral disorder that includes impairments in social interaction and developmental language and communication skills combined with rigid, repetitive behaviours. The disorder covers a large spectrum of symptoms, skills, and levels of impairment.

The number of children receiving diagnosis of autism has increased rapidly in recent years.

It is essential that training and educational needs of children with autism be met suitably. The Certificate Course in Autism Spectrum Disorder is designed to suit the requirement of parents and professionals who cannot attend a full time course in autism. The 12-week course is aimed to develop knowledge and skill in managing children with autism.



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Timing:

Sessions will be held for 4 to 6 hours every Saturday for 12 weeks

Objectives:

After attending the course a participant should be able to

- Develop an understanding of aetiology, nature and needs of autism
- Understand the aspects of child development and the process of screening and identification of children with autism
- Select and implement teaching methods and strategies suitable for autism
- Understand needs of family and promote community involvement in rehabilitation of persons with autism

Eligibility:

The Course is open to general and special education teachers, counselors, therapists, rehabilitation professionals, and parents/family members (with at least 10+2 certificate)
